Dear Parents/Carers,

As we approach the end of another extensive and successful sporting school year I would like to take this opportunity to outline the arrangements for The King's School Sports Day on Wednesday 20 July 2016.

Students will start the school day as normal on Wednesday 20 July. The Founders Day service will take place in St Wulfram's Church at 9:45am with an estimated finish time of 10.30am. Students will then be directed back to school for a break, to collect their belongings and instructed to line up in the Quad for a whole school registration (all year groups).

Following registration, all students will be escorted through Grantham to The Meres Athletics Stadium in Forms following a designated route. It is important to underline at this point that there will be no school catering and that all students should bring a packed lunch to school (free school meal pupils can collect a packed lunch from the catering team). Please also note that students will not be permitted to stop en-route to purchase provisions.

Sports Day will commence at 11.45am with a whole school registration on the running track and will finish with a further registration at approximately 2.40pm, after which students will either be escorted back to the school site or taken home by parents. If you would like to collect your son from The Meres or would like your son to be given permission to be released directly from The Meres please sign and outline the details below by the end of school on Monday 18 July.
