## **CAREERS TALKS**

We have an evening of Careers Talks scheduled in the school calendar for this term on Thursday 6 October between 4.30pm and 5.30pm. These talks are aimed at all students from Year 7 -13 and their parents and will take place in the Old School.

Richard Peberdy is an Old Boy of the school and works in Mergers and Acquisitions at KPMG in Nottingham. KPMG is a professional service company, being one of the big four auditors along with Deloitte, EY and PwC employing 174,000 people worldwide and has three lines of services: audit, tax and advisory. Richard studied Economics at Nottingham University and joined KPMG after graduating. He worked for four years gaining his professional qualifications and then worked in major cities around the world on individual projects. Richard will discuss career opportunities at a professional service company including the KPMG School Leaver and Graduate programme.

Sirah Parkes is a Chartered Surveyor working within the banking industry carrying out residential valuations for bank lending, probate and investment purposes. Sirah also carries out Homebuyer and Building Surveys, and has a passion and specialism in Period property. Sirah manages qualified surveyors for part of her working week and supervises the work of trainee surveyors. Sirah is also one of the lead surveyors in the development of innovative surveying technology that is widely acknowledged as the industry leader.
