You are invited to a talk in the Old School on Monday 11 March from 4.30pm - 6.00pm by Dr Aric Sigman on 'Preventing Mental Health Problems in Children'.

Dr Sigman is a Fellow of the Society of Biology, Associate Fellow of the British Psychological Society and a Chartered Scientist. He has worked extensively with the Department of Health, European Parliament and the Royal College of Paediatrics on teenage health. Dr Sigman is also a contributing author to the new Parliamentary Group report on Mental Health in childhood.

This talk will discuss practical and achievable steps that parents can take to strengthen children's mental health and resilience and reduce the risk of mental health problems developing.
