Dear Parents and Carers ,

## Re: Return to Extra-Curricular Sport

I hope that this letter finds you well. I am pleased to see Year 7 back in school again and I hope that your son enjoyed his first taste of theoretical PE via our 'teams' lessons. As we start to see an increase in the number of sports that are returning to training and competition we will now be restarting our extra-curricular sporting provision at King's.

Initially we plan to run football and rugby sessions after school. In each case we, as staff and coaches, will be adhering to the return to play guidance from the FA and the RFU respectively in these sessions. For further information on the return to play for each sport please see the websites for the FA and the RFU.

Sessions will take place after school and run from 4.00pm to 5.00pm. Please note that this programme will commence on the week beginning 28 September. The days for each sport and year group are shown below:

During these sessions we will be following the current school protocols with regard to sanitisation of sports equipment. Boys will be required to make use of the sanitiser station before and after each session. In order to preserve the year group bubbles each year group will use a separate changing room. As there will be different year groups at the field on any given evening pupils will be expected to wear face masks before and after training sessions; as they would for a communal area on the main school site.

In order for these sessions to be run safely and effectively we will be required to know who has attended each training session. This will enable effective 'track and trace' processes to be implemented should they be required. This is a departure from previous years in which pupils were able to simply turn up at an activity. As a result, if you are happy for your son to attend an extra-curricular activity please return the attached form to me as soon as possible, but by no later than Thursday 24 September. Pupils will not be able to attend, or take part, in any sessions without the completion and return of this form. Registers will be taken before each session starts. At the end of the session, pupils will be expected to leave the site promptly. If you will be collecting your son from these sessions I would ask that you are at the field 5 minutes before the end of the session to ensure a prompt departure.
