Year 11 Parents Evening

The Year 11 Parents Evening will be held on Monday 24 March between 4.30pm and 7.00pm in the School Hall. During this evening you will be able to discuss your son's academic progress and performance in the recent Mock Examinations with his subject teachers. All students are expected to attend the evening and sit alongside their parents so they can take an active part in discussions.

The Year 11 Report was issued at the end of last term. Please can I ask that you bring the Report with you to the evening, subject teachers may well wish to refer to this during your appointment so that targets and strategies for improvement can be agreed.

An appointment system will be operated for this event and your son will need to arrange appointment times with staff using the form in his school planner. There will be some parents we wish to make appointments with to discuss their son's progress. Mrs Wood the School Careers Advisor will also be available to discuss post-16 and career options.

Many Heads of Departments have organized Subject Support Sessions at lunch or after-school to provide extra support in the weeks leading up to the final GCSEs. A copy of the timetable is attached with this letter. We would encourage as many pupils as possible to attend these sessions in order to maximize their chances of success in the summer examinations. These sessions will be of benefit to pupils across the ability spectrum and will hopefully equip all pupils with the necessary support to achieve their potential.

GCSE examinations start on the 12 May and we shall continue to teach Year 11 classes throughout the examination period. We shall expect all students to attend timetabled lessons until Thursday 22 May. After this date staff will continue to provide timetabled lessons until Tuesday 17 June. Students will only attend lessons in those subjects that they still have to sit an examination. Students shall be free to go home after the last lesson of the day if they wish to; alternatively they may do some quiet and supervised revision in the library between lessons. There may be some students who are required to follow a full and individualised timetable during this period if we still have concerns regarding their effort and attainment.

All students who are intending to return to Sixth Form will be expected to attend the Year 12 Induction Week on the 30 June. This will provide a full week of A Level teaching and many subjects will introduce and start the AS course. There will also be homework and holiday work may be set. Please note that success in the Sixth Form is less likely without completion of this Induction Week.
