Dear Parents/Carers,

As we approach the end of another extensive and successful sporting school year I would like to take this opportunity to outline the arrangements for The King's School Sports Day on Tuesday 22 July 2014.

Students will start the school day as normal on Tuesday 22 July. The Founders Day service will take place in St Wulfram's Church at 11am with an estimated finish time of 11.45am. Students will then be directed back to school to collect their belongings and instructed to line up in the Quad for a whole school registration (Year 10 included).

Following registration, all students will be escorted through Grantham to The Meres Athletics Stadium in Forms following a designated route. It is important to underline at this point that there will be no school catering and that all students should bring a packed lunch to school (free school meal pupils can collect a packed lunch from the catering team). Please also note that students will not be permitted to stop en-route to purchase any provisions.

Sports Day will commence at 12.45pm with a whole school registration on the running track and will finish with a further registration at approximately 3.25pm, after which all students will be escorted back to the school site. If you would like to collect your son from The Meres or would like your son to be given permission to be released directly from The Meres please sign and outline the details below by the end of school on Thursday 17 July.
